Aim of the exchange:

The aim of this exchange is to allow an in-depth study of Italian experience in the planning and implementation of cohesion programmes, in a multi-level and partnership system, such as the Italian one.

In this perspective, also looking at the possible elements of significant interest for the actors of the Romanian system, the topics of the exchange have been selected as follows:

- ✓ methods/tools/databases to be used to map the main fields of intervention supported by the Programme
- ✓ needs analysis, how to define the criteria to select the regional needs to be supported in an impartial, fair and efficient way
- ✓ territorial strategies and partnership/place-based approach, how important is the role of sectoral/territorial strategies and what should be the involvement of programming authorities/bodies in supporting these strategies, how the strategies are integrated in the Programmes
- ✓ define the actions/fields of intervention and the output/result indicators and the corresponding financial allocations of a Programme
- ✓ coordination at national/central level in the case of multiple Regions with similar programmes
- ✓ administrative capacity actions for structures and personnel involved in programming
- ✓ the use of simplified cost options as a useful/efficient tool in designing and monitoring the Programme
- ✓ the use of financial instruments co-financed by National and Regional Programmes
